CONTAINER SERVICE AND DAMAGE AGREEMENT

PRICING: Our prices include up to 7 days of rental time. Unless otherwise arranged, containers remaining in customer possession for more than 7 days will be charged \$250 per container per week. \$0.00 dump fees for clean concrete, asphalt, granite, tile & brick pavers. Dump fees are \$20 per yard for C & D and \$20 per yard for Class III material. This includes up to 4 tons in a 20yd can, 6 tons in a 30yd can and 8 tons in a 40yd can. C & D is charged \$50.00 per ton over the included weight. Class III is charged \$100.00 per ton over the included weight.

CANCELLATIONS: If a customer's scheduled order is cancelled and PAW is not informed within 24 hours prior to the job date, the customer agrees to be assessed a "Cancellation Fee". This penalty will be either the full haul rate or \$175.00, whichever is higher.

CONTAINER ACCESS: The customer agrees to provide a hard-level surface and maintain a clear path for truck access to and from containers for loading and transport. In the event a truck is dispatched to deliver or pick up a container at the customer's request, but is unable to gain access, a dispatch fee will be charged at the project haul rate or \$150.00 per hour.

CONTAINER OVERLOADING: If loading heavy materials such as composition roofing, broken concrete, soil or rock then the 20-yard container should only be loaded up to 12 to 16 inches from the top rim of the container. If overloading beyond maximum weight occurs, the customer is responsible for offloading to allow for legal hauling and the wait time of the truck. If the container is unknowingly hauled and ticketed for an overweight violation, the customer will be allowed 1000 lbs. grace for a reasonable margin of error. Any amount over that will be charged at the rate of \$0.25 for each pound, plus cost of container / vehicle damage, and/or any violation charges incurred. Maximum legal weight is 70,000 G.V.W. Container cannot be filled beyond top edge under ANY circumstances. Nothing can be sticking out the top or sides.

CITY, TOWNSHIP OR COUNTY ORDINANCE VIOLATIONS: The customer agrees to be knowledgeable and aware of any codes, ordinances or laws regarding placing containers on their jobs. In the event that PAW is directed to place a container on your job, and it receives a code or ordinance violation, the customer will be responsible for any fines, levies or penalties associated with that container.

NO HAZARDOUS MATERIALS OF ANY KIND: No appliances, electronic devices, liquids of any kind, chemicals, fertilizer, oil drums, barrels, batteries, or propane bottles/ pressure tanks. Additional fees will be charged if any of the above items are found in our containers. The customer is responsible for monitoring and securing their container from illegal dumping by others while in your possession. If prohibited items are discovered in your load, the disposal rate automatically increases to the highest cost multiplied by the can size.

NO HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE, FOOD OR ANIMAL WASTE OF ANY KIND! PAW MATERIALS provides material recycling services only.

CONTAINER DAMAGE AGREEMENT: The customer agrees to assume full liability and is directly responsible for any type of damage to the containers while in the customer's possession. We do not allow our containers to be moved by customers. We will gladly come out and move our box for a small fee. If the container is damaged the customer will be charged repair costs.

CONTAINERS USED FOR WASHOUT: Unless previously arranged, washing out of concrete directly into our containers is prohibited. When approved, the customer agrees to provide adequate quality & thickness plastic sheeting, completely protecting all 4 sides and the floor of the from having any washout / concrete contact or adhering to the can in any way. Any material that adheres to the container, or is dumped or poured on the container, as well as any chipping or removal of concrete from our container will be charged at \$200.00 per hour with a \$200.00 minimum. This is non-negotiable. Washout containers can ONLY be filled 18" below the side rails. ALL overloads will be charged as outlined above.

WARNING AND WAIVER: If trucks and/or containers are to be driven inside the curb line, be advised that the size and weight of the vehicle and container could cause property damage. Please sign below to verify that you:

- 1) Have the authority to grant permission to allow our vehicle to enter the property or jobsite.
- 2) Acknowledge that placement of a container could result in property damage.
- 3) Accept responsibility of potential damage to driveway surfaces, tree branches, low wires, etc.

The undersigned has read and agrees to all of the above terms and conditions for service.

- 4) Accept responsibility for any such damage and waive damage claims against PAW Materials. As we are being directed, told, shown, or described where to place the container by the property owner or their authorized contractor.
- 5) Accept liability and fees for towing if our truck becomes stuck, due to a container being placed in noncompacted dirt, grass or soft unstable surface at the customer's request or direction.
